## The Eldorado Pool - New Rules and Hours!

Naivelt's favourite Eldorado Pool is now open on weekdays and weekends up until Labour Day- but don't jump in just yet. Along with the 2009 season comes some newly implemented rules and hours. The pool is open from 1-3 PM and 3:30-7 PM EVERYDAY; no confusion over what day it is anymore! Note that kids under 9 must be accompanied by someone older than 14 within the pool enclosure. A new wristband policy is also being implemented. A RED wristband is for a child 7-9 who passes the deep end test and must be accompanied by an adult on deck. A YELLOW wristband is for an accompanied child ages 7-10. A GREEN wristband is given to a child under 14 who is able to pass the deep end test, while a BLUE wristband is given to accompanied children between 10 and 14. Children are strongly encouraged to keep their wristbands so they do not have to take the deep end test more than once. Contact the lifeguards for more details or consult the "new rules" notice posted outside the pool. Passes this year will be \$11 for Naivelters: both credit card and cash payments are accepted. If you haven't fallen asleep reading these new policies by now, go take a dip in the pool already!
